



# Discover Your Future

## and Plan the Journey



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### *Has your student discovered their passion for a future career?*

These interactive sessions are designed to help 8th to 12th grade students become aware of what is possible, lead them to discover their passions and help formulate a plan to realize their dreams.

Many of today’s cutting edge careers in biology, chemistry, computers, energy, space, health care, social development, environmental management, . . etc. . . did not exist just 4 to 8 years ago. During each session we will guide the student to explore the topics that they are interested in, related to the latest science, math and technology discoveries. We then explore how these discoveries are accelerating change and what it will mean for the best career opportunities in the next 4 to 8 years.

The session will wrap up with an overview of how they can research these careers further and what they may need to do in order to take advantage of these opportunities. Each student will leave the class with a checklist that outlines the steps and timeline that a typical high school student needs to start working on today in order to enable their vision for the future and then fine tune a plan for after high school education.

**Logistics:** New and different material will be covered in each session that will run every other Friday from 6 to 8pm. Max of 10 students and minimum of 3 students / class.

**Materials:** All class materials and handouts are included.

**Class fee:** \$25\* per class or save \$5 per class if you pre-pay and register for 4 or more classes. Each class covers different material. The per class fee is due at time of registration to confirm a seat.

\*Note: A onetime per family new student registration fee of \$25 (normally \$75) is only required, if the family has not been registered with NewFuture Learning Center before.
